



CoP in Health: Access Afya

A successful cofunding deal

- Access Afya delivers healthcare to serve the needs of low-income markets using patient data to facilitate efficient diagnostic, operational and follow-up care pathways.
- Within the Community of Practice in Health, We Share Forward Foundation together with Bayer Foundation as the main donor supported Access Afya with a revolving grant. Philips Foundation unlocked follow up funding as a result.
- The revolving grant allows Access Afya to pay part of their revenue forward and support the next social entrepreneur.

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Access Afya **Milestones**

- Access Afya recently closed its \$1m Pre Series A funding part of a blended \$2.5m financing round. The close of the round will set the pace for growth of Access Afya's franchise model.
- Partnership with 3 multi-unit franchisees. Partnering with local health workers invested in operating their franchise model will unlock faster growth enabling Access Afya's impact to reach more people in increasingly scalable ways.
- 3 new micro insurance partnerships. Health financing through micro insurance products unlocks a large market – 80% of uninsured Kenyan's – to be able to access affordable and high-quality care and these partnerships enable Access Afya's network to serve these individuals through a portable and standardized tech enabled approach.
