
We are incubating **200 enterprises** and funding the **45 best ones** with pre-seed funding to create solutions for the future.

We created an impact-focused program -Building Back Better Through Social Entrepreneurship **co-funded by the European Commission**'s EU4Youth funding program.






Funding Facilitated By The Revolving Funding Model

Our tailored project carries out the entire process from pre-accelerator to pre-seed enable the young social to unding entrepreneur to scale up.





Project Milestones: Ecosystem Progress

Moldova

- Teachers trained
- 32 educational institutions involved: 1 university, 4 centres of excellence, 6 colleges, a vocational school and 20 high schools
- 860 students in incubation

Ukraine

- Trained: 105 educators from 42 educational institutions, 81 educators from universities,6 educators from colleges,16 educators from VET schools, 2 educators from schools
- 431 Students in incubation

Georgia

- 23
- 104 teachers trained from, 93 educational institutions, 56 educators from public schools, 12 educators from private schools, 17 educators from university, 4 educators from VET schools, 15 educators from Educational Centres
- 590 students in incubation

These donations will be re-deployed again in new social enterprises and the full cycle starts again; resulting in a self-sustaining source of philanthropic capital to be deployed exclusively to early-stage social enterprises.

DE-RISKING THE PIPELINE, MAXIMIZING FUTURE IMPACT

Social enterprises prioritise impact over profit and often struggle to secure early-stage funding to enable the development of their product.

Our program aims to bridge this gap by providing early-stage funding with early-stage acceleration to de-risk the pipeline allowing them to scale. Early-stage funding further de-risks the pipeline to impact investors who wish to invest with follow-up funding.



YOUR SUPPORT IS 100% ALLOCATED TO THE SOCIAL ENTREPRENEUR

Your donation will be 100% allocated to the social entrepreneurs through the revolving funding grant. The funding will be provided to each social entrepreneur to scale and maximise their impact. We Share Forward asks for a 5% contribution to cover only costs as a non profit organization. This amount is included in the 95,000 euros.
